These models have been optimally selected specifically for the needs of the modern collegiate and professional player.

C8 – A Sandlot Stiks original design and our most requested Maple Bat model today – This bat is the optimal choice for the player looking for maximum contact surface. This design incorporates the same overall shape as the very popular C243 however has been modified for the higher density of Hard Maple resulting in the most durable Large Barrel Maple bat available. End loaded balance and durable, this design features a conventional knob, .925” handle diameter with a Full Barrel.

44 – The Model 44 is a recently revived model. This model was extremely popular in the 60’s through the mid 1990’s for its durability and balance. The 44 utilizes the upper density range lumber and with its long even taper and .96” diameter handle makes it one of the most durable bats in our lineup; a great alternative to the more commonly known 110 design. This bat features a medium sized conventional knob, .96” diameter handle and slim long taper 2.40” diameter barrel. This is a great design for hitters of all types and an excellent metal to wood transitional bat.

72 – The Model 72 is best described as a slimmer version of the popular 141 shape. This bat is another that falls within the densest range of lumber. Featuring a standard conventional knob, thin .9375” handle diameter and end loaded 2.44” barrel, the model 72 is an extremely hard surfaced power hitter’s type design most notably used by Alex Rodriguez and Cal Ripken Jr. throughout their illustrious careers.

110 – The Model 110 is one of the most widely recognized shapes in wood baseball bats. This bat was originally created for the best switch hitter of all time Mickey Mantle. This model features a slightly tapered conventional knob with a .98” diameter handle transitioning to a large balanced 2.48” diameter barrel. This shape has been used by hitters of all types for years and remains one of the most popular bats shapes today. The combination of its slightly thicker handle and mid range density makes this bat a very durable shape. This is another excellent choice for the player transitioning from metal to wood.

141 – The 141 has gained popularity over the last 15 years due to its easy to handle shape and slightly end loaded balance and has remained one of our most requested designs. This bat features a medium .945” handle with a fairly obvious transition into its long medium diameter barrel. As with all our featured Collegiate Program bats, The 141 is another durable design utilizing the upper mid range in wood density for modern wood game bats and is a great bat for the metal to wood transition. It is appropriate for hitters of all types.

225 – The 225 is another Sandlot Stiks original design. Our most famous model because it was designed for Barry Bonds during the height of his career. This bat features a slightly larger flared knob with a slender .925” handle diameter which tapers rapidly into the long 2.52” diameter barrel. This design is best suited for the strong handed power hitter and utilizes medium density lumber. This design is a great choice for the player looking for a comfortable handle and maximum contact surface.

271 – The Model 271 is the most widely recognized wood bat model today. Most notably it was used by Ken Griffey Jr. throughout his entire career. This design features a tapered knob with a .925” diameter handle and long slow taper into an end loaded 2.48” barrel. This high density design is another great bat for those transitioning from metal to wood and is best suited for line drive and power hitters alike.
